

Accounting is a powerful profession and can empower women to a great extent. With diverse career options and great recognition, Chartered Accountancy is a lucrative professional option for Indian women today.


The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development provided us with 17 development goals, but also SDG 5, which is about "Achieving gender equality and empowering all women and girls", in all circumstances. This has put women empowerment at the focus of the international community. India is a dynamic economy with an aim to be a USD 5 trillion economy by 2024. Every country in the world is keeping an eye on India as one of the fastest growing economies and the largest democracy in the world. The target of USD 5 trillion economy cannot be imagined without the active support and contribution by Women which are 48.04% of its total population.

ICAI through its Committee for Members in Industry & Business (CMI&B) and Women & Young Members Excellence Committee (WYMEC) is conducting placement programme specifically designed for women members only, to explore more placement opportunities for those women members who want to work on a flexi-time/parttime/work from home basis. The number of women in the Chartered Accountancy profession is growing significantly. In the year 2000, women constituted only 8% of ICAI membership. The situation has changed drastically over the years and their strength increased to 19% in 2012 and 22% in 2014. Today, women Chartered Accountants constitute more than 29% of the total number of members at ICAI (1,14,656 out of total 3,91,711 Chartered Accountants) and are successfully contributing to various fields of the profession and also outside the profession. These numbers are encouraging for the future of the Indian Accountancy Profession. But despite of these progresses, there are still a lot of efforts required to be made to empower women.

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), in its existence of more than seven decades, has always played active role in professional development of its members. In the spirit of empowering women members, the ICAI has been keeping women-member specific initiatives high on its agenda. Through a dedicated Women & Young Members Excellence Committee (WYMEC), ICAI has been taking several measures to develop capacities of women members to effectively utilize their professional knowledge and expertise.

We cordially invite esteemed organizations and CA firms for participation in this special placement drive exclusively for women Chartered Accountants. # GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATIONS

- The companies participating will have to register online at https://cmib.icai.org/ under tab Career Ascent
- The companies can access the database at https://cmib.icai.org/
- Participating companies will have to upload the list of shortlisted candidates online on placement portal https://cmib.icai.org/
- Final list of candidates appearing for interview will be available online at https://cmib.icai.org/ one day after consent date by candidate at respective centres.
- Interviews will be conducted through virtual mode by the platform convenient to the participating organization as per their roster.
- Shortlisting of the candidates by the company is restricted to 7 times of the number of vacancies in that particular organization.
- Once a company has selected any candidate and the offer is accepted by the candidate, it is the responsibility of the company to inform the centre heads, the details of whom will be provided by ICAI.
- There is no minimum CTC prescribed.

# GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERS

- Women Chartered Accountant (not holding full time COP) having membership on 30th September, 2022 or prior to that are eligible to participate.
- Members who wish to register for the placement programme shall be required to remit a registration cum participation fee (non-refundable) amounting to Rs. 500/-
- The members must register online at https://cmib.icai.org/ under the head 'Career Ascent'.
- A member can consent for only three (3) recruiting entities for interview irrespective of the number of recruiting entities shortlisted her.
- Interviews will be conducted through virtual mode by the platform convenient to the participating organization as per their roster.
- Link for attending virtual interview will be shared by participating organizations with all consented members at their e-mail id registered at the placement portal.
- Once finally selected by any organization and on accepting the offer by signing the
  offer letter of respective organisation/declaration provided by ICAI, the member
  cannot appear for any other interview or accept job from any other recruiting
  organisation that have interviewed her in the placement programme.
